CDC Report on Female IPV Homicides

According to a new report from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, more than half of all female homicide victims are killed by a current or former intimate partner. In 98.2% of these deaths, the perpetrator was male.

While the report shows that intimate partner homicide occurs across all racial and ethnic groups, black and indigenous women are murdered at significantly higher rates than other groups.

The report concluded that risk assessments that evaluate risk of lethality are an effective way to intervene in the most serious cases.

"Racial/ethnic differences in female homicide underscore the importance of targeting intervention efforts to populations at risk and the conditions that increase the risk for violence. IPV lethality risk assessments might be useful

tools for first responders to identify women at risk for future violence and connect them with life-saving safety planning and services."
